Francis Robert Atkinson and his wife Emma with their two sons Albert and George came out to Australia in March 1911. They lived in South East Queensland., started out by share farming with his half brother Thomas Atkinson around Buderim and Maroochydhore area, (farmed strawberries and bananas) Francis, Frank as he was known, cleared land for farming by cutting down trees, he built a house from the timber lived in it for a short time and sold it. The selling bug got hold of him apparently, because he exchanged land for a Hotel and so forth... It is said he moved 22 times in his life time of 48 years.

While in England, he worked in the Coal Mines as a powder monkey. He went to USA in 1910 at the request of his half brother Tom Bayliff, and worked in the Scofield mines in Utah for a short time. Emma was still in England. Frank wrote to Emma and asked her if she would like to go to America, or should he come home and go to Australia. She chose Australia.

While here in Australia, Emma got home sick for England, so as a surprise one day Frank came home and said they were going back to England. They set sail in 1919 arriving back at Worksop. Vera was born while there. They were there for a little over twelve months and decided to come back to Australia, arriving back in the New Year of 1921. Bought farming land just opposite to where they were in 1911. Starting all over again, built another house exchanged it for a Hotel, that didn't work out, so went in for Sugar Cane farming, bought land on Mapleton Road, Nambour.
